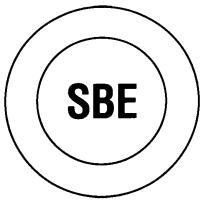


Where do I find new members?

Prospective members can be non-members attending chapter meetings, fellow engineers at work or at other stations, suppliers or educators. How do I get credit for new members? Give prospective members a membership application and ask him/her to fill in your name on the line "Sponsor's Name/Who introduced you to SBE." (You may write or type your name in this space before making copies.) You may also direct them to apply online by telling them to go to "Join SBE" on the SBE website. Once the new member's membership application has been approved, your name will be placed in the prize drawing, which will take place in July 2007.

Official rules

Only SBE members in good standing (National dues paid) who are sponsoring new or reinstatement applicants for Member, Associate Member and Sustaining Members are eligible for the prize drawings. Each new member application may have only one sponsor. All applications are subject to approval by the Admissions Committee per the SBE By-Laws. Each approved application will earn \$5.00 off the recruiter's 2007 membership renewal, up to \$25.00. New Member, Associate Member and Sustaining Members must have a sponsor listed on their application to be eligible for the New Member Prize drawing. The Golden Recruiter Awards are given to two chapters based on the median chapter size as of December 31, 2006 (Class A is made up of chapters that have membership less than the median, and Class B is made up of chapters that have membership greater than the median). Applications must be received at the SBE National Office between 8 a.m., March 1, 2007, and 5 p.m. May 31, 2007, EST, to be eligible. Copies of the membership application are acceptable. Drawing for all prizes will be in July 2006. Only one prize will be awarded per recruiter. Winners will be notified by mail. Grand prize winner and his/her new recruit may choose \$500.00 cash in lieu of his/her trip. There are no other prize substitutions. In the event the grand prize winner sponsors more than one new member, the companion trip will be drawn from the grand prize winner's new recruits. Winners are responsible for any taxes on prizes. Employees of SBE are not eligible for prizes. Contest void where prohibited.



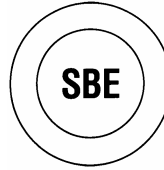
REASONS TO BECOME A MEMBER OF THE SOCIETY OF BROADCAST ENGINEERS
